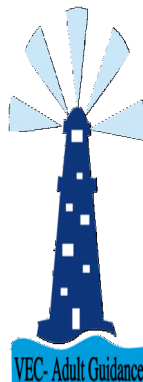

## **What can CWVEC Further Education Centre Wicklow offer you?**

- **Free Part Time Courses** to those who left school early or are on social welfare payment/credits/dependents or a full medical card
- Opportunity to progress to **employment** or **further education**
- Recognised **National Qualifications** from **FETAC**



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## What is BTEI ?

### Back To Education Initiative

- BTEI is a part time programme for those who left school early **or** those in the home **or** on a social welfare payment
- Students must complete at least three modules each year and can achieve a full certificate over a number of years
- Tuition is **free** if you left school early or are in receipt of a Social Welfare Payment or have a FULL Medical Card. If not, you will have to pay for the Modules or Course

### Ladybirds Crèche

- Onsite, caters for children from 3 months to 9 years and free places

### Canteen Facilities

- with fresh sandwiches made onsite with tea and coffee facilities

## Courses on offer under the part time BTEI programme

**BTEI Certificate in Community Care**  
**FETAC Level 5:** Social Studies, Human Growth and Development, Care Provision and Practice, Safety and Health at Work, Work Experience, Occupational First Aid and Communications all at FETAC level 5.

Painting, Computer Applications, Information Technology, Cultural Studies, Communications, Food and Nutrition all at FETAC Level 4

### **BTEI Digital Creator:**

The qualification comprises of eight units. Five cover the creative aspects of digital media which include Animation, Digital Audio, Moving Image Language, Digital Still Images and Video. The remaining three deal with sharing work using presentations, optical media and the Internet.
